



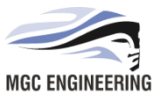
### Ingham's Enterprises

This state-of-the-art live bird storage facility is fully climate-controlled, making it the only one of its kind in Australia. An awning was then constructed onto the extension, supporting Ingham's commitment to animal welfare standards.

This new facility enabled Ingham's to increase production capacity to meet growing customer demand for their poultry products.

Ingham's and Wiley worked in close collaboration to ensure the safe and humane storage of live birds on site; with animal welfare and full industry compliance being the key objectives for this project.

### The challenging scope Wiley delivered

Wiley delivered a temperature-controlled area to store the increased volume of live birds. The new holding area was built using insulated panels and fans which are automatically controlled by the climate.

This innovative solution provides a cool, shaded environment for the live birds during the hot, humid Queensland weather and provides a cost-effective solution for the business.
